

Picture to PDF for iPhone

1. Open photos on your iPhone and tap albums. Select the image you want to convert.
2. Tap Share (the box with an arrow through it on the bottom left of the screen)
3. Choose Print from the Share Screen (I had to scroll down to get to the print screen)
4. Using two fingers on the photo preview, pinch outwards to save the photo as a PDF (a message flashed that the image was now saved as a PDF)
5. Email the image/pdf to yourself and then you should be able to upload it

Picture to PDF for Android

1. Find and launch **Google Photos app** on your Android device. Grant it the permission to access your media files if prompted. Find and open the image file you want to convert in the Photos app.
2. Tap on the **Menu** icon (three dots) at the top right corner to bring up the action menu with options to delete the current photo, use it in other apps, print it out to papers, etc. See below figure.
3. Choose **Print** to open the printer settings and preview screen.
4. Click **All Printers** to expand the drop-down menu.
5. Instead of selecting an available printer, choose **Save as PDF**.
6. Tap on the **PDF** button to choose a folder on your mobile phone, give the PDF file a new name and save it.
